





Current Waikato economic outlook



Next 12 months Waikato economic outlook








Previous 12 months staffing level changes



Next 12 months expected staffing level changes




Business revenue performance over past 12 months



Business profitability performance relative to previous 12 months




Profitability expectations for the next 12 months




Growth intentions for the next 12 months



Top 5 major barriers to growth




Top 5 regional infrastructure priorities






How should investment in priority regional infrastructure be funded?




